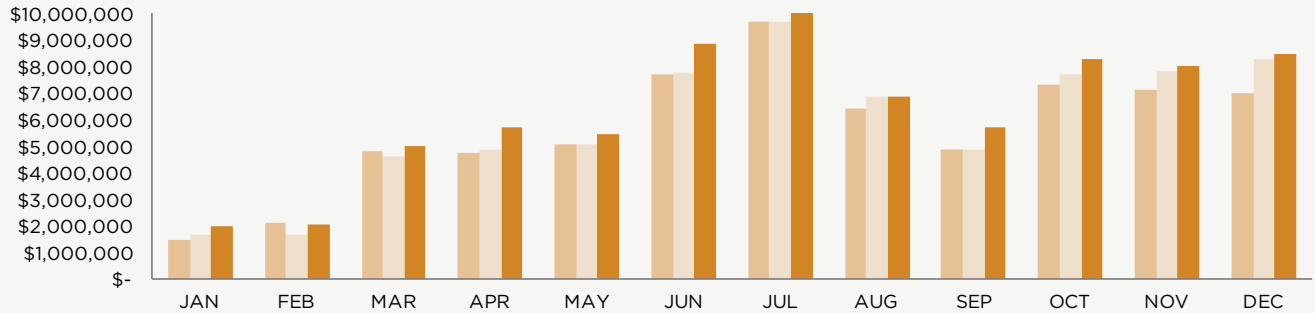




Theater Revenue
